Eligible Breeds:

LGRA: Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds and Sloughi.

NOTRA: Afghan Hounds, Basenji, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds and Sloughi.

LGRA Race Meet: Race meets will be 3 programs, 4-dog races, 200-yard drag lure. All breeds will start from the box, except Borzoi, Scottish Deerhounds and Irish Wolfhounds, which will be hand slipped.

NOTRA Race Meet: Race meet will be 3 programs, 4-dog races, 350-yard modified-oval, drag lure. All breeds will start from the box, except Borzoi, Scottish Deerhounds and Irish Wolfhounds, which will be hand slipped.

Box dimensions: Length: 35", Width: 11", Height: 33.5"

Eligibility to compete:

All hounds must be 1 year of age, or older, on the day of the race meet, and must be neither lame, sick, nor in season.

Each hound must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC), Canadian Kennel Club (CKC), United Kennel Club (UKC), or with the National Greyhound Association (NGA). Hounds registered with the AKC under Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) or Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or the CKC equivalent may also be entered.

First Time Entry (FTE) Dogs

Any FTE dog as well as any dog that has ONLY incomplete meets on its record will be required to have a certification run prior to the Nationals.

Proof of certification shall include:

- The name and signature of the Race Secretary who qualified the dog;
- The name of the club that the Race Secretary represents;
- The date of certification;
- A statement that the dog came out of the racing box and ran the entire track cleanly with another dog of the same breed or one with a similar racing style.

See form at the end of this premium. You may use this form or a substitute, as long as the required information is included.

Proof of certification can be presented either:

- With the entry form OR
- at roll call if certification occurred after the entry closing.
- If a dog cannot find a meet for certification prior to the Nationals, the host clubs will set up a track for certification purposes on Friday, September 8th at the event site, Goldendale, WA.
- Your dog MUST be already entered in the meet for the event (LGRA or NOTRA) in which it requests certification.
- You must e-mail Karen Sanders: allagantesilkens@yahoo.com to set up an appointment for your cert run.
- These certification runs will be BY APPOINTMENT ONLY to ensure that someone is at the field when you arrive.
- You must provide a bye dog. Only one FTE may run for certification at a time.
- A dog that is an FTE in NOTRA, but has competed successfully in LGRA, must STILL provide proof of certification in NOTRA before it is allowed to compete in NOTRA;
- however, a dog that is an FTE in LGRA and has competed successfully in NOTRA (can show a complete meet in the NOTRA grading guide) OR
- has completed a successful certification run will not have to provide proof of certification to compete in LGRA.

Box Training: All inexperienced dogs

All dogs will be required to start from starting boxes. Training for all dogs will be held along with FTE certifications on Friday, September 8th, 2017.

There is a fee of \$2 for box training.

Entries:

There are no entries allowed on the day of the meet. All entries must be received by **8:00 pm on Thursday, August 17, 2017**. All entry fees MUST be received with the completed entry form and worksheet.

Entry Fees:

First hound: \$25 each event

Additional hounds (same owner and household): \$22 each event

Family Plan (five or more entries, same owner and household): \$100 each event

FTE: \$2 registration fee per sport (you must provide a COPY of your registration papers with your entry, one for each association).

Box Training for FTE/inexperienced dogs: \$2 per hound

"Spirit Racer": \$1 per hound (see below)

If at roll call, your dog is lame or in season, or if your FTE dog fails the schooling run on September 8th, your entry fees will be refunded.

"Spirit Racers" Memorial Race

Before commencement of Program Three, there will be a "Spirit Race" after the lunch break on Saturday. By honoring the cherished racers past, may we be reminded that their spirits guide us as we perpetuate our sport. The name of each dog being memorialized will be, in some fashion, "raced" down the track. This will be announced so that everyone may pay tribute.

Eligibility: any sighthound (whether owner is present, or not) that has gone to the Rainbow Bridge since the 2016 LGRA/NOTRA Nationals.

Entry: use form provided in this premium list, check the box on the Worksheet, and enter fee of \$1.

Veterans and Legends:

We will not have special Veteran and Legend runs this year, but still want to honor those who have retired.

Legends:

We are providing a special LEGENDS section in our catalog. We are offering half-price full-page ads to the first ten (10) legends who submit their ads. (If you procrastinate and miss being one of the first 10, you can still have your dog's ad in the LEGENDS section at the regular catalog ad price).

Eligibility:

Your hound may not be entered in the regular meet, must be 6 years of age or older and must have earned at least a GRC title in LGRA or an ORC title in NOTRA.

Veterans:

A ribbon will be awarded to the high-scoring veteran in each breed.

Eligibility:

Your hound MUST complete all 3 programs and must be 6 years of age or older on the day of the meet

Roll Call and Inspection:

7:30 am SHARP each day. Racers not present at roll call will be marked absent and are **not** eligible for refund. Racers will be inspected for lameness, sickness, being in season, and correct fit of racing muzzle.

Volunteers:
